

ABRC Lifeguard Job Description

As a lifeguard at the ABRC pool, your primary responsibility is to provide a safe swimming environment for our pool patrons. This includes accident prevention, rescuing individuals in danger of drowning, providing first aid and/ or CPR when necessary. In addition, lifeguards are required to perform routine pool and facility maintenance, assist in the snack bar, assist with special event set-up and take-down, and assist with the enforcement of facility rules. Lifeguards are also required to attend mandatory in-service training.

Applicants must hold a current ARC Lifeguard Training certification, along with an ARC First Aid/ CPR certification.

Work permits are required for applicants under the age of sixteen (16) and may be obtained through the [Virginia Department of Labor and Industry](#). The link can be found on the ABRC website.

***Applicants must submit a completed application and two (2) letters of recommendation. The letters of recommendation could be from teachers, coaches, previous employers, clergy, or adult Scout leaders.**
